SMC (School Management Committee) Meetings

The SMC meetings are held with a futuristic purpose to mitigate the problems of the teachers and the taught. It observes and analyses the requirements for a successful teaching learning process in the 21st Century.

The SMC unanimously passed and executed the following plans for the session 2022-23

1-The unused area of the school ground was made useful and available for the students by developing the same into a vast lush green area with sporting facilities.

2- The students who became the victims of the pandemic were benefitted under "MAHATARI" Yojna.

3-The students whose parents became jobless or in financial crisis during the pandemic were benefitted by remitting tuition fees either partially or fully as per their official document of income status.

4-Other benefits as per CBSE norms were also implemented at the time of registration.

5- Free Vaccination drive for students of age 12-14 of second dose and booster dose in nearby locality in the month of March and April was also organized.

6-Approval of proposal for construction of new Classrooms and activity halls was approved and construction of the same has started which is proposed to complete by April 2023.

7-In the beginning of the session 22-23 remedial and revision classes were organized to reduce the learning gap and learning loss of the weaker students especially who belong to the remote rural areas.

8- Procurement of open land for meeting of extra space for school activities was approved and 5000 sq.foot land was purchased in session 2022.

Fee committee Meeting:-

Fee committee of Chhattisgarh Public School was constituted as per C.G government Fee regulation act-2020. The Members of the committee in the meeting for fee finalization for session 22-23 after discussion it was decided to keep the fee for session 2022-23 same and no increment in fee was

proposed which was approved by school level committee and forwarded to district education department from where it was approved and implemented in session 2022-23.

PTA Meeting:-

The PTA meeting was held twice in the session 2022-23 on virtual mode and following important suggestion were proposed for academic wellbeing and pandemic awareness-

1 The Bridged classes were proposed for students to overcome the learning gaps due to the pandemic under guidance of teachers in the beginning of offline classes in new session..

2 Panel of teachers to be created to look into the issues in teaching and learning.

3 Fee for new academic session was also decided.

4 Need of special stress on management of behavioral changes in students and parent.

Many milestones have been achieved and many still have to be reached will continue our unceasing efforts to mould the young minds into well balanced personalities with confidence and zeal befitting the standards of this portal of education.
